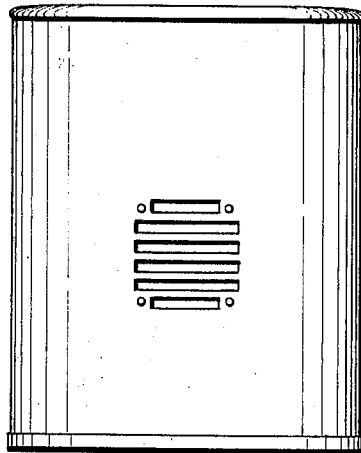

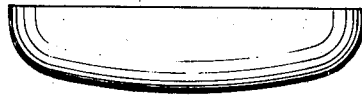

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Laurens Hammond, a citizen of the United States and resident of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tone Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a tone cabinet showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and

Figure 3 is a top plan view thereof.
